HABC Level 2 Emergency First Aid at Work

Following a recent review of the Health and Safety (First-Aid) Regulations 1981, the HSE is introducing a new Emergency First at Work qualification (EFAW). This 1-day course has been developed in order to satisfy employer's responsibilities in line with the new HSE Risk Assessment of First Aid needs.

The new qualification will be launched on the 1st of October 2009. From this date, training providers will be able to offer the new EFAW qualification through an Awarding Body accredited by the QCA.

All successful students will be issued with a new Emergency First Aid at Work certificate which lasts for a period of three years, along with a wallet-sized plastic card detailing their qualifications.

1-day.

→ Assessment

Ongoing practical and oral assessment throughout the course by the tutor.

Successful candidates must be able to demonstrate an understanding and ability in the 8 different subjects specified by the course syllabus.
