

Level 2 Award for Personal Licence Holders (NCPLH)

Designed for: The law requires alcohol sales on licensed premises to be made or authorised by a personal licence holder. Individuals applying for a personal licence must hold an accredited licensing qualification such as the HABC Level 2 Award for Personal Licence Holders (NCPLH).

Course duration: 1 day

Aims

The aim of the HABC PLH qualification is to provide candidates with essential knowledge of the legal framework surrounding the sale of alcohol in England and Wales. This includes key information on the responsibilities of personal licence holders, duties of the Designated Premises Supervisor, the role of licensing authorities and police powers regarding licensed premises.

Course Content

The qualification covers the following topics:

- Premises Licences
- The Protection of Children
- Powers and Enforcement
- Temporary Events
- Responsibility in Alcohol Retailing
- Licensing Law
